## Award of Excellence for Art Therapy Research

This \$400 award is given in recognition of outstanding research in art therapy. It is jointly subsidized by the Art Therapy program of Concordia University and the Association des art-thérapeutes du Québec. The award is open to both professional and student members of the AATQ.

### **Admissibility criteria:**

- 1- Be a professional or student member of AATQ (members who hold a full time position at the art therapy program of Concordia University as well as members of the Education and Research Committee of AATQ are excluded).
- 2 - The research must be pertinent to the practice of art therapy.
- 3- All forms of research can be realized through either an historic methodology: theoretical or clinical subject (case study) or an experimental methodology, qualitative or quantitative, and concern a clinical or other subject.
- 4- The research must be conducted within the preceding year. It will not have been presented during a course given within an art therapy training program neither will it have been published in another context.
- 5- The research can be submitted either in French or in English. The English submissions will follow the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA). The French submissions will follow the Guide de présentation des rapports, mémoires et thèses en psychologie de Daniel Prince, Université de Montréal, (1989) or La présentation de thèses et rapports de Pinard et al. (1977).
- 6- The written text will be 10 to 20 pages.
- 7- Three copies will be submitted.
- 8- The report submitted will be anonymous. The name of the author as well as any information identifying the author (phone number, address, etc.) will be written on a separate sheet of paper.

**DEADLINE :** Your submission must be postmarked by **June 1st**.
