



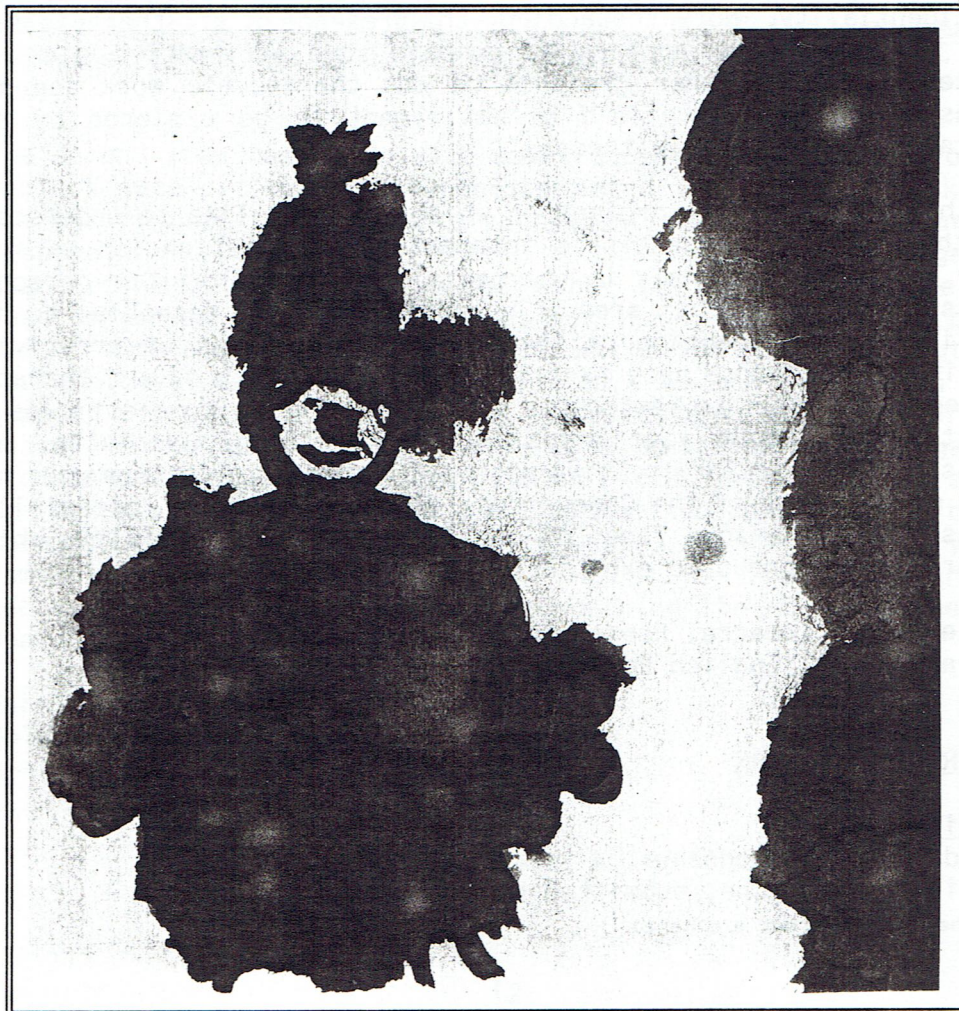

Hester Katz Memorial Award

The A.A.T.Q. Board of Directors is pleased to announce the establishment of an award for excellence in writing to be presented to an art therapy student member. We have chosen to make this award in the name of Hester Katz who was an original member of the Association and who created our logo. Those who knew Hester respected her desire for excellence, were all saddened by her untimely death, and consider this an appropriate opportunity to recognize a student's work in her name.

The award of \$100.00 will be presented annually to an art therapy student whose paper has been chosen by an adjudication process of the Ad Hoc Memorial Award Committee. This year the award will be presented during the opening ceremonies of the 10th Annual Conference, May 1, 1993. The paper will be published by A.A.T.Q. in the forthcoming year and may be on any topic relevant to art therapy.
